Mission: Providing a continuum of care that includes housing and support services for people with physical disabilities as well as rehabilitation and inpatient nursing home care.

Program Funded:

Located in Farmington, New Horizons Village offers 101 adults with physical disabilities the opportunity for self-directed living. First opened in 1986, the Village combines accessible housing with non-medical and transport support services.

In 2022, New Horizons partnered with the Town of Farmington in order to bring a community pickleball program to New Horizons Village. The Town hosts bi-weekly pickleball matches in New Horizons' great room and in turn is able to offer employment opportunities for the residents of New Horizons Village! Many of the New Horizons' tenants have faced significant challenges in finding part-time employment opportunities in the past. New Horizons is in need of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) machine for the community pickleball program. This vital machine is used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest.
